1. All children will be good readers by age 14 (minimum expectations L5b)
2. All children will be writers by age 14 (minimum expectations L5b)
3. All children will be good mathematicians by age 14 (minimum expectations L5b) with secure mastery of **all** basic operations and numeracy skills
4. All children will have secure mastery of key scientific concepts and skills by age 14 (minimum expectations L5b)
5. All children to have acquired and mastered key scholarly habits by age 14
6. All children to support the school ethos with outstanding behaviour, being responsible and rightful in all they do
7. All children to attend school for more than 96% of the year
8. All children to attend on time (to aim for 0 but have no more than 5 lates per year)
9. All teaching to be consistently good and frequently outstanding
